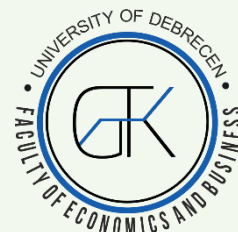

### **About Debrecen**

Debrecen is a mid-sized city in Hungary. Debrecen is the educational and cultural center of eastern Hungary, and it is also known from healing thermal water spa (<https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Debrecen>). Debrecen is ranked as the 5<sup>th</sup> on 'Best Value 2017' list of Lonely Planet (<http://www.lonelyplanet.com/best-in-travel/value?paffil=lp-affiliates-CJ> ). In January, the weather is usually cold, the average temperature is below zero degree.

### **Venue**

The workshop will be held at the Faculty of Economics and Business of the University of Debrecen. The University has four campuses in Debrecen, of which the one on the Böszörményi street will hosts our Faculty and so the workshop.

### **Travel**

Debrecen has some direct rail connections with European cities (Vienna, Cluj-Napoca). The city has good connections with Budapest, the capitol of Hungary via road and rail networks. Journey from the railway stations Budapest Nyugati or Budapest Keleti and Budapest Airport can be planned here <http://elvira.mav-start.hu/elvira.dll/x/index?language=2> .

Flights from Munich, Milano, Eindhoven, London and Paris departs on Debrecen Airport (<http://www.debrecenairport.com/en/>).

It is easy to use public transport in Debrecen, conference venue is available in 10-20 minutes from city center and other campuses of the University as well. It is worth to use the 'Debreceni Menetrend' app, which contains airport shuttle timetables as well, and it operates with route planner and real-time data also in English version.
