## TO THE FIRST MILESTONE EVENT OF THE “INCREASING THE COMPETITIVENESS OF THE HUNGARIAN ECONOMY THROUGH THE IDENTIFICATION OF THE TARGET GROUPS AND CONTENTS OF PUBLIC HEALTH INTERVENTIONS” PROJECT

In the framework of the “Excellence of Strategic R&D Workshops” (GINOP-2.3.2-15), programme, the University of Debrecen was awarded a grant of HUF 1,464 million. The aim of project number GINOP-2.3.2-15-2016-00005 is the description of the most important conditions and risk factors causing susceptibility to diseases with high public health importance, as well as the identification of evidence-based public health interventions that can be efficiently used for their elimination and mitigation. The results of the first year of the project, as well as the further tasks of the six working groups will be discussed at a “First Milestone” meeting, which is open to the press. Three members of the Advisory Board of the project will also participate on the meeting: Dr. Piroska Östlin, Director of the Division of Policy and Governance for Health and Well-being of the World Health Organization Regional Office for Europe, Dr. Tamás Szentés, deputy state secretary responsible for the tasks of the chief medical officer, and Martin McKee, professor of the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine. The working language of the event is English; the press conference – in Hungarian – will be held from 13:30.
